

The Dryvit 30 Year Warranty Program

Dryvit has developed an exclusive 30-year homeowners warranty program for one and two-family homes built by builders that use the Dryvit Residential MD System[®] or the Dryvit Sprint MD System[®]. The warranty – the first of its kind in the EIFS industry – applies only to the construction of one and two family homes, and requires that builders, and the applicators they choose to apply the system, meet specific quality-related criteria outlined below. And, if you decide to sell your home, you can transfer the warranty to the buyer by simply notifying Dryvit of the change.

Dryvit Residential 30 year program requirements

Builder Must:

- Be an NAHB member
- Possess applicable state/local licenses
- Conform to all applicable state general liability coverage requirements
- Attend a Dryvit EIFS program for homebuilders
- Possess a current Dryvit Residential MD/Sprint MD builder listing

EIFS Installer Must:

- Possess a current Dryvit Residential MD/Sprint MD listing
- Possess a current AWCI EIFSmart certificate
