

Accent Base Finishes

Dryvit Finishes that require a higher volume of pigments to tint bright, bold or dark colors utilize Dryvit Accent Base for that specific Finish type and texture. When an Accent Base Finish that contains larger aggregate is applied loosely, gaps can form between the aggregate allowing the lighter base material to show through. In order to minimize the higher volume of pigments required for a color, the amount of hiding agent in the Accent Base is reduced. Application of a matched **colored primer** helps hide the color of the base coat providing the intended color to match factory samples.

For this reason, Dryvit is recommending that prior to the application of a Dryvit Accent Base tinted Finish, a color matching primer be applied to the base coat. These primers include:

- Dryvit Color Prime
- Dryvit Primer with Sand

Note: Dryvit utilizes three finish tint bases, Pastel Base, Mid Base and Accent Base. The tint base for each color selection should be verified before mixing, as color formulations do occasionally get updated..
